If end punctuation should be changed, or added, put in the right punctuation and draw a circle around it.

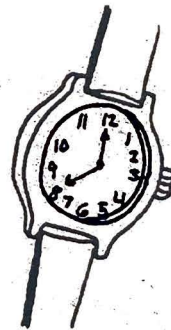
The bird flew out of its nest? (should be a period)

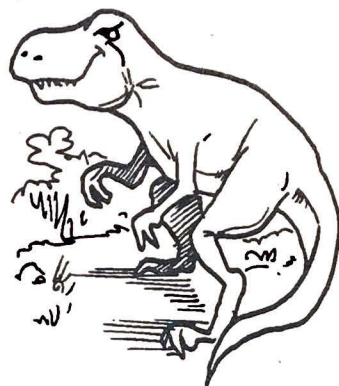
